Pastor's Message

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Curiosity about life, awareness of its end, hopes connected with it - these feelings accompany us for a large part of our lives. We would like to live our life well, with dignity, health and happiness, to die at home, on our own bed, surrounded by family and friends. But is it real? Is it possible? Or is it just our "wishful thinking"?

We are approaching the end of the liturgical year. The Church reminds us of the Lord's words, calling us to watch over his return. We should prepare for this by responding resolutely to Jesus' call to conversion. Let us not be fooled by human curiosity as to when the "day of the Lord" will come. It would be useless to investigate, because although it is certain that it will come without fail, only God knows when and how. And it is not only the final coming of the Lord, but also His coming at the end of the earthly life of every human being.

Today's Gospel speaks of talents to make us aware that those who belong to Christ in faith and live actively in anticipation of his return can be compared with "a good and faithful servant" who rationally, efficiently and fruitfully administers the goods of the absent Lord. What does talent mean? Talent is a unit of weight that was adopted in many ancient countries as the basis of the money system, but in the Gospel context it means "gifts" that are shared by every human being. These are our abilities that, humanly speaking, nature has endowed us with. Life observation shows the great wealth of these talents. However, are we aware that each "talent" is a call and an obligation to work on ourselves and to work for others?

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La curiosidad por la vida, la conciencia de su fin, las esperanzas relacionadas con ella: estos sentimientos nos acompañan durante gran parte de nuestra vida. Nos gustaría vivir bien nuestra vida, con dignidad, salud y felicidad, morir en casa, en nuestra propia cama, rodeados de familiares y amigos. ¿Pero es real? ¿Es posible? ¿O es solo nuestra "ilusión"?

Nos acercamos al final del año litúrgico. La Iglesia nos recuerda las palabras del Señor, llamándonos a velar por su regreso. Debemos prepararnos para esto respondiendo resueltamente al llamado de Jesús a la conversión. No nos dejemos engañar por la curiosidad humana mientras preguntamos cuándo llegará el "día del Señor". Sería inútil investigar, porque, aunque es seguro que llegará sin falta, solo Dios sabe cuándo y cómo. Y no es solo la venida final del Señor, sino también su venida al final de la vida terrenal de cada ser humano.

El evangelio de hoy habla de talentos para hacernos conscientes de que quien pertenece a Cristo en la fe y vive activamente en anticipación de su regreso puede compararse con "un siervo bueno y fiel" que administra racional, eficaz y fructíferamente los bienes del Señor ausente. ¿Qué significa talento? El talento es una unidad de peso que fue adoptada en muchos países antiguos como la base del sistema monetario, pero en el contexto del Evangelio significa "dones" que son compartidos por todas las personas. Estas son nuestras habilidades que, humanamente hablando, la naturaleza nos ha dotado. La observación de la vida muestra la gran riqueza de estos talentos. Sin embargo, ¿somos conscientes de que cada "talento" es una llamada y una obligación para trabajar sobre nosotros mismos y para los demás?
